What needs to be turned in

The Family Projects MUST be turned in. Each week the Poetry Folders must be returned, and all work in the Blue Folders must be taken out and reviewed before returning to school on Monday.

Required Assignments

Family Projects – Each month there is a family project that needs to be completed AND returned. I would like for the project to be worked on as a family, but please allow your Kindergartener to take charge of the projects. The projects range from decorating a picture to disguising a turkey, and they do not require a great deal of time or money to complete. Have fun with these projects! ©



Poetry Folders – Throughout the year, your child will learn a poem, song, or nursery rhyme each week. Poetry Journals will be utilized in the classroom Monday-Thursday. They will be in your child's backpack on Thursdays. If the poem is not in the prongs, please place it behind the poem from the previous week. There will be an assignment at the top of the page for your child to complete. Please make sure your child touches each word as they read. They should practice reading their poems several times throughout the week to help promote good reading habits! Parents must initial the small box at the top of the poem once completed. Poetry folders must be returned by Monday. By the end of the year, students will have a collection of poems that they can read!



Blue Folder Work – all activities completed at school will be sent home in your child's Blue Folder on Fridays. It is imperative that you provide your child the opportunity to discuss what is on the papers and projects, and to read their books to you.
